
















B2 - Curved Timber Bench



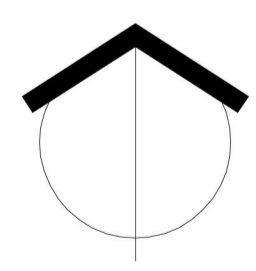
F1 - Potential Focal Feature
