Design Report

The application site is located on the southern edge of West Boldon village in a rural area of South Tyneside. It is located close to the original village centre that contains many older stone and brick built buildings and is within a designated Conservation Area.

The property is a purpose built two- storey dwelling set within a courtyard development and is constructed in smooth red brickwork, natural slate roof with off-white painted timber windows.

Amount:

The proposal is for a single storey rear extension.
