

Along the A183 we will be installing a 1.8m high stone wall forming the garden wall of plot 22. See sketch image below.



The proposed bus stop will be to the front of this wall. The closed boarded fencing in the image will form the Southern Boundary. Below the fencing will be a brick retaining wall taking it down to the existing ground levels in this area. The metal railings shown are existing and will be made good where required.

There is an existing drop from the public footpath to the adjoining land to the South of the site. Currently this is retained by a stone wall shown in the image below. It is also guarded by the existing metal fencing. In the image below the heras fencing indicates where the southern boundary is.

The install of the stone wall and Southern boundary will not create any issues in regards to a member of the public falling from height. Any land past the Southern boundary of the site is privately owned land and will be as existing.
