Assessment

Planning permission ref: 250540 was granted on 17/10/2025, subject to planning conditions.

Condition 6 sets out that:

Prior to the commencement of remedial works, a Detailed Remediation Strategy for the remedial works shall be submitted to, and approved in writing by, the Local Planning Authority. The scheme must include all works to be undertaken, proposed remediation objectives and remediation criteria, timetable of works and site management procedures. Where remediation of gas has been identified as necessary a gas verification plan shall be submitted for the proposed gas protection measures. The scheme must ensure that the site will not qualify as contaminated land under Part 2A of the Environmental Protection Act 1990 in relation to the intended use of the land after remediation.

In the interests of land contamination and in accordance with the NPPF and LDF Core Strategy EA1.

The Biodiversity Net Gain (BNG) Condition sets out that:

The effect of paragraph 13 of Schedule 7A to the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 is that planning permission granted for the development of land in England is deemed to have been granted subject to the condition "(the biodiversity gain condition)" that development may not begin unless:

(a) a Biodiversity Gain Plan has been submitted to the planning authority, and

(b) the planning authority has approved the plan.

This application seeks to approve the required details required by condition 6, and the BNG Condition.

To accompany this application, the applicant has submitted a Remediation Statement in relation to condition 6, Baseline and a BNG Plan, Baseline and Proposed Habitats Plans, and Statutory Biodiversity Metric Calculation Tool and Assessments in relation to the BNG Condition. A Proposed Swallow Nesting Plan has also been provided in relation to the proposed tree planting species (and linked to application ref. 250760).

The Countryside Officer has been consulted on this application and considers that the submitted details are acceptable in relation to the BNG condition, whilst the Environmental Protection Officer considers that the submitted details are acceptable in relation to condition 6. As stated above it is noted the BNG condition is also linked to planning permission ref. ST/0749/24 covering a different part of the site, and where the BNG condition for that application has also applied to be discharged (ref. 250760).

Having regards to the above it is considered that the submitted information would be in accordance with the aims and objectives of LDF Policy EA1. Therefore, it is considered that the information required by condition 6 and the BNG condition are acceptable regard to the consultation responses from the Environmental Protection Officer and the Countryside Officer in regard to the information submitted, and that the proposal would accord with LDF Policy EA1.
