



Hedge Planting

1.2m high green wire mesh fence to inside of boundary for security

- plant between 1 November and 31 March
- prepare a planting strip at least 1.5m wide with good soil conditions
- clear existing vegetation to remove competition for new planting
- only apply herbicides to the 1.5m strip in August or September before planting
- remove all individual guards and tree shelters once the plants are established
- replace all failed plants in the following planting season
- trim the newly planted hedge within the first 2 years of agreement to encourage bushy growth, allowing the hedge to become taller and wider at each cut

Native Indigenous Hedge planted 2 rows 40 cm apart that staggered with at least 6 plants per metre .
Min topsoil to BS3882:2007 depth 300mm protected with shrub guards
60% Hawthorn 40-60cm tall,
20% Blackthorn
15% mix of Hazel, Holly
5% Crab Apple, Guelder Rose

Grass Seed

Where new grass seed to be planted, Emorsgate EM7 Meadowgrass for Sandy Soils

Tree Planting

At Beach Nursery, trees planted with 2m clear stems, 12-14 girth, mix of native Silver Birch (Betula Bendula) and Rowen (Sorbus aucuparia).

To Gazebo avenue, Hardy Ornamental Prunus serrulata Shirofugen Zone 3 (Japanese Flowering Cherry) Trees
2m clear stems 14-16g 3.5m high
