[REDACTED] had requested the following information regarding the use of the Farm:

"If the site is used as an agricultural use then we would require evidence of this, as the site does not have the appearance of a farm building. This evidence we require would usually include, but is not limited to, the County Parish Holding Number (CPH) and your Single Business Identifier (SBI), and then details of the animals which you have and how many – this may be through your Annual Inventory which is the record of any livestock on the holding."

The Cattle shed exists and has been in existence for over 40 years measures 67ft x 66ft. There is also a cattle yard as well as Cattle holding pens for upto 67 Cattle.

The Holding No is 30-705-0029

The SBI is 106271786

The British Cattle Movement Service BCMS exists, whereby the L.A. has a right to access their records.

There are currently 27 cows (in calf) on site, these are due to be born 1 February 2027 onwards.
